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Hello there!

We are so excited that Kids Camp is coming up soon. We've grown so much that we added a second week this year. The weeks are June 16th-19th and 23rd-26th. Once again, the Children's Ministry Team, the Program Directors, and I have worked hard to make our program, worship experiences, and recreational activities better than ever before! We are so excited to welcome back **Scott Watkins** (FBC Kingfisher) as our Week One Pastor and **Brian Waddell** (FBC Mountain View) as our Week Two Pastor. Our Worship Leader for both weeks is **Chris Hopper**, a Worship Arts and Media Director from Ardmore. We have a simpler schedule, more activities, and big improvements to the program. The price for camp this summer is \$100, what a bargain! The Camp is cashless, no more lost money at camp! Each camper gets a \$10 concession wristband included with their registration. They can purchase additional wristbands, if purchased before camp starts. Please ask parents not to send their kids to camp with cash. They won't be able to use it.

Look for this year's *Sponsor Training Video* from Craig Towery soon on the WOBA website (www.goWOBA.net) after April 1st. All sponsors and junior sponsors need to watch it *before* camp.

Remember - Sponsors over 18 years of age who stay overnight must complete a background check that includes a Social Security number check. Please attach a copy of their report to each Sponsor Registration Form (Form 2).

Sponsors must complete the Sexual Abuse Awareness training by Ministry Safe. WOBA will send your sponsors the link to the training once you share their full name, email address, and mobile number with us. The training must be completed before they come to camp.

One more thing – on Sunday afternoon, April 27th, bring your kids to the **Spring Thing** camp preview event (see the enclosed poster). It's a great time of worship with our Camp Pastors and Worship Leader, a hotdog feast, and lots of fun activities and games. The Children's Ministry Team planned this activity to get the kids excited about camp and to get them thinking about inviting their friends this summer to hear the gospel! The **Spring Thing** is from 3:00-6:00 P.M. at the camp and there is no charge for this event. Even if your kids are not going to Kids Camp with us this year, your church is still invited to the **Spring Thing!** Come join us!

KIDS CAMP INFORMATION

Camp Dates: June 16-19 and 23-26, 2025
for kids who have completed 3rd-6th grades

COST: \$100 (includes registration, meals, lodging, insurance, concessions, and a camp T-shirt)

CONDUCT: Campers must conduct themselves in a Christ-like manner. Campers are required to participate in Camp activities and to obey the Sponsors' and Program Director's instructions at all times.

ATTIRE: God-honoring and modest apparel is required at our Christian camp. Each sponsor ensures that their group is dressed appropriately. The Program Director will have the final say, should there be disagreement. Shirts and shoes must be worn outside of the cabin. Shorts are acceptable at camp; no dress clothes are needed for camp.

SECURITY: Security gates are closed at both camp entrances to restrict access to authorized individuals only. Visitors must call the number posted at the gate for admittance. The sponsors get real-time information through an app on their phones.

EMERGENCIES: The Camp has emergency procedures in place for accidents, fire, intrusion, and severe weather. Sponsors are trained about these eventualities. If you have an issue, it is best to call your church's group leader. In the event of emergency, call (405) 570-1542.

BELL: The bell in the center of camp calls campers to worship, Bible study, and change activities. A prolonged ringing of the bell is the signal for campers to go to the Tabernacle for instructions. Only authorized persons may ring the bell.

SWIMMING POOL: A certified lifeguard is on duty at the swimming pool. Life jackets are NOT provided for campers, but campers may bring them to camp. Poor swimmers should stay in the shallow end of the pool. A cover-up must be worn to and from the pool, and T-shirts must be worn over two-piece swimsuits.

HIKING: Hiking is an option early each morning. Long pants and close-toed shoes are required for hiking (no exceptions).

CABINS: The Program Director assigns the cabins based on group size. Girls are never allowed in the boys' dorm and vice versa. Defacing the cabin, camp property, or the natural environment is not acceptable; violators may be prosecuted and held financially responsible for damages. Children are never left alone in the cabins without supervision.

SPONSORS: Sponsors undergo required background checks by the sending church, and complete the sexual abuse prevention training, provided by the Camp. Each church will bring one adult sponsor for every ten campers. The sponsors are always available to the children and are never alone with child.

INSURANCE: The camp insurance, included with registration, is a secondary insurance policy that supplements your primary insurance coverage.

CURFEW: Campers must be inside their cabins for the evening cabin devotionals by 9:30 p.m. “Lights out” for the camp is at 10:30 p.m.

PRANKS AND FIGHTING: Pranks, shaving cream fights, water fights, water balloons, and water gun fights are forbidden. Fighting is not acceptable behavior, especially at a Christian camp and may result in a camper being sent home.

SEXUAL BEHAVIOR: Any sexual behavior or contact is unacceptable and will result in a camper being sent home and possible criminal prosecution.

FIRST AID: A Camp Nurse is on duty. Any camper too ill to attend classes or services will not remain in the cabin but will go to the Camp Nurse’s station and remain under the Camp Nurse’s care.


K.P. DUTY: Each group takes their turns doing K.P. in the cafeteria, the “Caf.”. For insurance purposes, only adults can serve from the steam tables.

CONCESSIONS: The Camp is CASH FREE. Participants are provided with a concessions bracelet, good for ten items. Additional bracelets may be purchased from your sponsors prior to camp. The concession stand is open during all free times. Food, candy, and drinks are not allowed in the pool area. Only bottled water is permitted in the Tabernacle and the pool.

ROCK THROWING: God put those rocks exactly where He wanted them, so for safety reasons, throwing rocks is not permitted.

The rules exist for the safety and well-being of all our participants, as well as the protection of the camp and its environment. Please help us by ensuring compliance. Thank you.

Instructions for Camp

BEFORE CAMP

1. Do your **Background Checks**, good for two years, on all sponsors over the age of 18, who stay overnight, and attach the report to the back of their registration (Form 2). The background check must be from one of the approved providers:

2. Send the list of your sponsors (full name, email, and cell) to office@gowoba.net and WOBA will send them the link to complete the **Sexual Abuse Awareness Training**, required every  three years.
3. Please have all your sponsors **watch the Sponsor Video and the Encourager Video** before they come to camp.
4. The Program Director will call your group leader the night before to get your headcount, so a cabin can be assigned to you.
5. Sort the individual forms alphabetically please, and don't forget to bring a check.

ON THE WAY TO CAMP

Call (405) 401-6788 as soon as you LEAVE your church and tell us how many kids you have in your group, plus how many sponsors and junior sponsors, so we can get your group's packet ready.

ONCE AT THE CAMP

Send a sponsor to the Caf to register your group.

1. Turn in a **Form 1** for every student.
2. Turn in a **Form 2** for every sponsor and junior sponsor. **Please ATTACH each sponsor's background check report to the back of Form 2.**
3. Turn in **Form 3**, which is your *2025 Kids Camp Group Registration*, and pick up your group's Camp Packet (posters, schedules, wristbands for activities, concession wristbands, and handbooks for each camper and sponsor, and lanyards for the sponsors).
4. Pay the camp fees (\$100 per person plus \$10 for each additional concession bracelet). Please make checks payable to WOBA.
5. Get the Wi-Fi password for the camp. For Sponsors Only
