We are all sinners. Read Romans 3:23. Sin is doing things our way instead of God's. How do you feel when you think about your sin?

Our sin separates us from God. Read Romans 6:23. God has a punishment for sin, just like your parents have a punishment when you disobey them. Dying would mean being separated from God for forever.

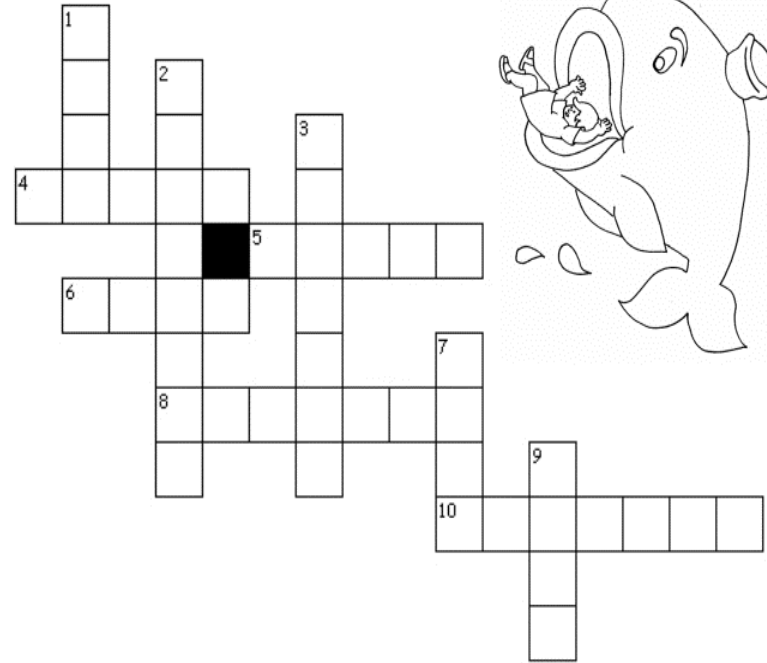

- * CONDUCT: Conduct yourself in a manner that is appropriate to the occasion & to obey sponsor's & camp director.
- * ATTIRE: Dressing & modest apparel is required. Ensure you're dressed appropriately, and in good agreement. Shirt & shoes must always be worn.
- * BELL: The bell is for transition times.
- * SWIMMING: Properly worn life jackets must be worn in the water. Life jackets are required.
- * HIKING: Hiking is only permitted in the adult sponsored areas. Take drinking water with them, but other mountains.
- * CABINS: Do not move beds or mattresses are never allowed in the boys' dorm; boy ing camp property or the natural environment financially responsible for damages.
- * CURFEW: Everyone must be inside their camp. Lights out is at 10:30pm.
- * PRANKS/ FIGHTING: Pranks, shaving cream gun fights are forbidden. Fighting is not permitted.
- * SEXUAL BEHAVIOR: Any sexual behavior/ contact with the camper being sent home & possible consequences.
- * CONCESSIONS: Concessions are available. Health regulations require that no gum, the Tabernacle.
- * NOT PERMITTED: For safety, alcoholic beverages, knives, weapons, throwing rocks and campfires.
- * LEAVING: Leaving camp without the camp director's permission is not permitted.
